

Scripture Cake

1 cup Judges 5:25 (butter)

He asked water, and she gave him milk; she brought forth butter in a lordly dish.

1½ cups Jeremiah 6:20 (sugar)

*To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country?
Your burnt offerings are not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.*

4 Jeremiah 17:11 (eggs)

*As the partridge sitteth on eggs, and hatcheth them not; so he that getteth riches, and not by right,
shall leave them in the midst of his days, and at his end shall be a fool.*

2 cups Exodus 29:2 (flour)

And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers

2 teaspoons Amos 4:5 (baking powder)

*And offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with leaven, and proclaim and publish the free offerings; for this
liketh you, O ye children of Israel, saith the Lord God.*

1 teaspoon each Chronicles 9:9 (nutmeg and allspice)

*And she gave the king a hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and
precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave King Solomon.*

2 teaspoons Exodus 30:23 (cinnamon)

*Take thou also, unto thee the chief spices; of flowering myrrh five hundred shekels, and of sweet
cinnamon, half as much.*

A pinch of Mark 9:50 (salt)

*Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves,
and have peace with another.*

1 tablespoon 1 Samuel 14:25 (honey)

And all they of the land came to a wood; and there was honey upon the ground.

1 cup 1 Samuel 30:12 (raisins)

*And they gave him a piece of a cake of figs, and two clusters of raisins; and when he had eaten, his
spirit came again to him; for he had eaten no bread, nor drunk any water, three days and three nights.*

1 cup chopped dried Song of Solomon 2:13 (figs)

The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines with the tender grape give a good smell. Arise my love, my fair one, and come away.

1 cup slivered or chopped Numbers 17:8 (almonds)

And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yield almonds.

1 cup chopped Genesis 43:11 (walnuts)

Take of the best fruits of the land in your vessels and take the man a present, a little balm, and a little honey, aromas, and myrrh, nuts, and almonds.

4 cups cored, peeled, and coarsely chopped Psalms 17:8 (apples)

Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

Follow Solomon's advice for making good boys and you will have a good cake!

Proverbs 23:14

Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.

Instructions

1. Soak raisins in boiling water for 15 minutes; drain well and pat dry; toss with a little flour to coat
2. Grease 9x13 inch pan; set aside.
3. In large mixer bowl, beat the 1 cup butter and gradually add the sugar at medium speed until light and fluffy.
4. Beat in eggs, one at a time.
5. In a separate bowl, combine flour, baking soda, salt, allspice, nutmeg and cinnamon.
6. Add to butter mixture; beat at low speed until well combined.
7. Stir in chopped apples, figs, raisins, honey, almonds, and walnuts.
8. Spoon batter into prepared pan. Bake in 350 degrees F. oven until wooden pick inserted near center comes out clean, about 50 to 60 minutes.
9. Cool in pan 15 minutes; invert onto wire rack to cool completely. Best if prepared 1 day before serving. Store cake covered at room temperature.
