

Why sponsor a family of refugees?

The conflict in Syria has led to millions of people being displaced, both within Syria and in the neighboring countries. This is such a large problem that many of us think that we can't make difference. That is not true.

You can change the lives of one family. Fairlawn Avenue United Church wants to give one family an opportunity to start a new life in Canada. We can do that with help from our congregation, our friends and our community. You can help us.

How much does it cost to sponsor a family?

We need to raise funds to support the family for a year while they transition to their new country.

Our goal is to raise \$35,000. This will cover start-up, monthly expenses and a small contingency amount. This amount will allow the family a very modest standard of living.

We have raised well over half of the necessary funds but there is still a ways to go. We invite you to contribute to this designated fund as generously as you are able. Donations will be tax-receiptable.

How does it work?

Fairlawn will apply for a family under the guidance of AURA (Anglican United Refugee Alliance).

We plan to apply for a family of five. They are United Nations designated refugees and will have likely been living in a refugee camp for some time.

How will Fairlawn support the family when they come to Canada?

- **Financial support for 12 months**
- Start-up support – find and furnish an apartment, meet at airport
- Integration – help find a doctor, schools, language class, government services, interpreters, employment
- Emotional support
