COVID-19 Vaccination Policy at Fairlawn

Note: These guidelines are intended to comply with current Public Health requirements and recommendations.

Our Policy Guidelines

We have an obligation to keep our employees, congregants, and other visitors as safe as possible.

As we have a vulnerable population within our congregation, we request that all those planning to attend in-person services at Fairlawn be fully vaccinated unless prevented due to ineligibility or health issues.

Vaccination, fresh air, masking and social distancing remain the primary preventative strategies for personal safety. As our church building is not well-ventilated, we will continue to follow Toronto Public Health guidelines to require the following: masking, social distancing, hand sanitization, use of Toronto Public Health's screening tool and contact tracing protocols.

It is important to note that this approach is not foolproof against COVID-19, and in fact, we understand that even fully vaccinated individuals are not 100% protected from the virus.

We ask that you do your own risk assessment to decide if you want to participate in in-person activities.

Our plan for church services once we are back in the sanctuary is to continue offering an online version on YouTube as we do now.

We continue to monitor the guidance from Toronto Public Health and the United Church Shining Waters Regional Council and are reviewing potential future vaccination policies on an ongoing basis.
