Full COVID-19 Vaccination Required at Fairlawn Effective November 21, 2021

Gathering in worship is at the heart of who we are and what we do as the people of God. Throughout the pandemic, the Re-entry Task Group continues to evolve our church entry protocols, based on guidelines from Toronto Public Health.

These ongoing protocols were designed to ensure the safest experience possible and at the same time, create a welcoming and supportive place for us to gather.

Proof of Vaccination

As of November 21, 2021, all members of the Community of Faith and visitors attending worship services, with the exception of those with a letter of a medical exemption or children under the age of 12 (until vaccination is available for those aged 5 – 11), must be fully vaccinated (two doses) against the COVID-19 virus. We will ask you to show proof of this.

There are several ways you can provide proof of vaccination.

You will be required to show your proof of vaccination only once. It will be noted on a master record and no further proof is required.

- Present your certificate in digital or paper form or the original vaccination receipt of your second dose, on Sunday mornings before worship to the designated volunteer who will note receipt. If you show a paper certificate it will be returned to you.
- Email a copy of your certificate as a PDF to Church Administer Joanne Christie at joanne@fairlawnavenueunited.ca . Once reviewed and noted, the PDF will be deleted.
- Mail a paper copy of your vaccine certificate to Rev Douglas duCharme at the Fairlawn office, 28 Fairlawn Avenue, Toronto, ON, M5M 1S7, marked confidential. The sealed envelopes will be collected once weekly, noted by Joanne Christie and a confirming email sent to you that your vaccine certificate has been received, noted and shredded.
- Arrange a Zoom video call with Joanne Christie at joanne@fairlawnavenueunited.ca to show your vaccine certificate.
