

Eleanor Daley Appointed as an Officer of the Order of Canada



Today, Her Excellency the Right Honourable Mary Simon, Governor General of Canada, announced that Eleanor Daley has been appointed as an Officer of the Order of Canada.

Eleanor Daley is recognized "for her contributions to Canadian music and choral culture as a renowned composer and accompanist."

Officers of the Order of Canada (OC) are appointed to "recognize achievement and merit of a high degree, especially service to Canada or to humanity at large."

This year, 2022, has marked Eleanor's 40th anniversary as Director of Music at Fairlawn Avenue United Church, Toronto. Earlier in the year, Eleanor was awarded an Honorary Doctorate by the Senate of Queen's University, Kingston, Eleanor's alma mater.
